

How to name recordings

- Store recordings in a task folder, i.e., ./database/rhythm/
- Use codes for anonymization
- Naming convention by Tereza Tykalová:
 - Unique subject code LETTERSnumbers (HC101), where LETTERS = group
 - A suffix can distinguish sessions
 - Numerically LETTERSnumbers_1R (HC101_1R)
 - With a date LETTERSnumbers_year-month-day (HC101_2019-6-24)
 - Last (optional) character (a, b, c, ...) indicates retests within one session
LETTERSnumbersCharacter (HC101a), LETTERSnumbers_1Rcharacter (HC101_1Ra), or LETTERSnumbers_year-month-day (HC101_2019-6-24a)

Storing folders

- Use standard names for tasks
- Avoid spaces to increase compatibility
- We use following convention:
 - ./database/rhythm for **rhythm task**
 - ./database/phonationA for **sustained vowel /A/**
 - ./database/phonationI for **sustained vowel /I/**
 - ./database/ddk for **diadochokinetic test**
 - ./database/text for **reading passage**
 - ./database/monologue for **monologue**
